The Southeastern Conference is responding to this disaster and are offering ways your church, Disaster Response Coordinators and Community Service Leaders can help, such as:

1. Monetary donations are needed promptly. Make all checks payable to Southeastern Conference of SDA and send monetary donations marked "Disaster Response" to the attention of Southeastern Conference of SDA, Community Services Department, 1701 Robie Ave., Mt. Dora, FL 32757.
2. Certified Crisis and Elderly Care Workers who can be deployed for a period of two (2) weeks. These workers will work in conjunction with the American Red Cross. Deployment will be determined by the North American Division.
3. Volunteers are needed. Teams of 5-7 people who can be placed on a rotation basis for a period of one (1) week. Deployment will be determined by the North American Division.
4. A list of items needed in Houston will be provided to Southeastern Conference by the North American Division. The list will be generated upon receipt to all Southeastern Conference churches. The North American Division will also provide further information on its collaboration with Amazon and Wal-Mart and let us know how donations can be made.
